In your account, go to the section Password & Security.Scroll down and you will see an area, reading in big letters TWO-FACTOR AUTHENTICATION. Here you can choose, which form of 2FA you want to use: Email, SMS or an authenticator app.Et Voila, that's it! You now have 2FA activated in the Epic Games Store and can go back to player-to-player trading in Rocket League. The change was introduced in Patch v1.93 and also affects players who own the Steam version of the game.**Luckily, activating Rocket League 2FA is a relatively simple process, so you'll be able to get back to trading fairly quickly. First, you need to log in to your Epic Games Store account. If you go through the official website, you'll then need to hover over your username in the top-right corner and select Account from the drop-down menu. You can also left-click on your username in the launcher and select Manage Account, which will open a browser page and take you to the same section. Left-click on the Password & Security tab, then scroll down. You'll see three 2FA options and you can choose whichever suits you best to trade in Rocket League.**Authenticator App** requires you to enter a code found in mobile apps like Google Authenticator or Authy. SMS Authentication sends the security code to your phone via text message, while email makes sure you get it on your email of choice, as explained in an official article. You'll then need to enter the security code when logging in.**If you previously owned Rocket League on Steam but chose to use a shell (platform) account when it became free-to-play and moved to the Epic Games Store, you'll need to upgrade to a full Epic account to continue trading.** Psyonix has confirmed. I've seen countless posts complaining that their trading career is over and they don't want to upgrade to a full Epic account and so on. The update would ensure that players could only trade with a fellow human being, and not a bot that could be misleading and scamming users. The patch recently dropped earlier today, Feb. 15, and would be focused on bringing better gameplay for its users, particularly with bug fixes and removing several glitches found in the game.
